Music is to be saved into the 'Official Music National Championships 2023' Dropbox in your club folder by 6pm on <u>1st April</u> by Head Coaches. Coached should also ensure a backup of each routines music is available on USB during the competition <u>Submit Here</u>

Please ensure that your recordings have a **5 second lead in time** from the time the 'play' button is pressed and when the music starts and a **5 second end time at the end of the recording** plays to allow the Music Operator to stop the music before the next piece of music.

- All music should be in MP3 format the file name
- Please note that the 13-15 age group name has been changed to Youth
- Incorrect recording or naming of music WILL NOT be accepted.
